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A direct commission from the Gateshead commissioner, Shibdon Bank was an urgent requirement for 3 potential residents in their early twenties, needing to take their next steps into their own home.

Working directly with the families, Commissioner and Occupational Therapists, we developed a bespoke plan to cater for each individual's specific needs. Among others these including being single story, open plan, ample turning spaces, en suites, wet rooms, a secure garden, kitchen diner, close to families and local amenities.
